I give and bequeath to the Children of my Baid Brother Robert Nesmith all the rest residue and remainder of my Property both real and Personal, of what nature or Kind soever, or wheresoever found: And in case any of the aforesaid children Should die under age or with out leaving lawfull ISS-ue, then the deceased childs part shall be equally divided Amo-nest the Survivors.-----And I do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my said Brother Robert Nesmith Executor of this my last Will and Testament; hereby revoking and making Void all ~~for~~ former Wills and testaments at any time heretofore by me made; and do declare this to be my last Will and Testament.
