and Alexr J Scott as Executrix of this my last will and testament hereby Revoking all former wills and wills by me made at any time made and Declaring this as my last will and testament (hereby Revoking all former will and wills by me at any time made and Declaring this as my last will and testament) in testimony--- I the said Lucy Owens have hereunto set my

hand and seal this 3 Day May 1812 -
