and Alexr J Scott as Executrix of this my last will and test-
ament hereby Revoking all former wills and wills by me made
at any time made and Declaring this as my last will and test-
ament (hereby Revoking all former will and wills by me at any
time made and Declaring this as my last will and testament)
in testimony--- I the said Lucy Owens have hereunto set my
hand and seal this 3 Day May 1812 -
