the purpose of carrying this my last will & testament into effect I appoint Mr George McConnell junier & John Cotea junier as my Executor in Witness where off I have hereunto set my hand & sele this twenty third of February one thousand eight hundred & Sixteen & in the Independance of the United States the fortieth year
