I Mary, Ann, McGill of the State and District aforesaid being of sound mind and disposing memory do make and Publish this my last will and testament in manner and form as follows to wit.

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Item 1-- I give devise and bequeath to my son Minto W McGill, all my real estate to be his absolutely and forever upon conditions of praying into the hands of my Executors at the time of the division of my property the full and Just sum of four hundred Dollars-----

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Item 2-- It is my will and desire that all my Negroes (except the girl Bina) be equally divided between my children that each child shall hold his or her portion during his or her natural life after his or her death then such portion with its increase shall go to their children but if either of children share die leaving no lawfull issue I give^{*} and devise the portion of the child so dining with its increase to my surviving children during their lives and after their death to their children

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Item 3-- As my daughter Jane Caroline Scott is in more needy circumstances than my other children I give devise and bequeath to my said daughter Jane Caroline Scott over and above her share of my negroes during her natural life and after her death to her children the negro girl Bina with hir future increase

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Item 4-- It is my wish that the negro woman Nancy and Victory shall have the liberty of selecting to which of my children they would prefer to belong and that it be so arrange in the diviseor of my Negroes

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Item 5-- I give devise and bequeath to my four daughters Elizabeth. A. Scott Jane Caroline Scott Mary McCotry Burges and Mary Ann Sanders Murphy my four peices of mahogany furniture

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Item 6-- I give devise and bequeath to my grand daughter Mary Ann Scott one feather bed as a token of my remembrance

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Item 7th The residue of my estate after the payment of all my Just debts shall be equally divided between all my children

Item 8th I do hereby constitute and appoint my son in law John T Scott and my son Samuel Davis McGill the Executors of this my last will and testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this sixth day of September in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and forty nine
