Cooper twenty shillings. 3" give and bequeath to my daughter Nancy McCutchen, during her natural life. one negro boy named Paroe. also two girls named. Philis and Cloe and their increase, and at the death it is my will that said negroes and their increase be divided among her children share and share alike 4 " I give and bequeath to my daughter Clizabeth W. McCutchen and her hiers, one negro boy named Prince. 5th I will my Watch to my son in law George McCutchen Jr. 6 . I give and bequeath my wearing apparel, and my books which have my name written in them to my daughters Nancy McCutchen and Clizabeth W. McCutchen. 7th I will my large family Bible containing the family records to be kept in the family. 8th I give and bequeath to Indiantown Congregation twenty dollars. 9th All the rest residue and remainder of my Estate and effects of what nature or kind soever, not herein before disposed of, after payment of my just debts, funeral expence and the expence of proving this my Will: I will to be appraised by three free holders, chosen by my Executrix and Executor, without applying to any court whatever, and equally divided between my daughters Nancy McCutchen and Clizabeth W. McCutchen share and share alike. 10 . Should my Executrix and Executor consider it necessary to sell any part of of my Estate I do hereby authorize them to make such sale: And lastly noninate and appoint. my daughter Nancy McCutchen Executrix and my son in law George McCutchen Executor of this my last.
