Joseph Wilson, Benjamin Wilson, John P. Wilson, and William Wilson, all the rest and residue of Est. Real and personal. and I wish it understood that if my daughter Majah, should die leaving no lawful Issue the above named negro Rose shall be equally divided between the four last named Son's, and if any or either of the four last named Son's should die leaving no Issue the last named daughter Majah shall have a full share with the remaining son or sen's extra of the nego above bequeathed. And it is my will and desire that the Land shall be rented out and the negros hired, untill the youngest Child shall arive to the age of 21 years or marry
