Item 1

I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Drusiler
Braveboy & my beloved son Moris Murfey Braveboy & my
beloved Daughter Elizabeth Braveboy & my beloved son
Moses Murfey Braveboy provided we should have any more
children I give unto them all that plantation or tract
of land on which I now live to be equally divided amongst
them all, as the children should come to the age of twenty
one years of age

Item 2

Together with all my personal estate that is to say
a negrow man named Lunnon & Boston a negrow woman named
Nance & six children to wit Abe & Cloe & Jake & Jiny & Nance
& tobe All sure my stock of horses & cattle and hogs &
plantation tools Household and Kitchen furniture & other
implements of husbinry to tedious to be mention

Item 3

The stock Horses & cattle & hoes household & Kitchen
furniture plantation ^{tools} and other implements of husbidry are

& Testament in manner & Forme following that is to my funeral charges & all my lawful & juste debts To be payed in convenient time after my Death and all the legacies hereinafter bequeathed are to be discharged as soon as circumstances will permit & in the maner herein after directed-----

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Item 3

The stock Horses & catle & hoes household & Kitchen furniture plantation ^{tools} and other implements of husbidry are to be kept on the plantation an disposed of at the discretion of my Executors

Item 4

I give unto my daughter Margaret Thomas five dollars in cash as my deceased

Item 5

I give unto my daughter Annis E Matthews & her issue all that plantation or tract of land on which she has formerly resided containing two hundred Acres, To have

and to hold during her natural life together with acertain negrow woman named Harriet And for sundry causes The said tract of land or two hundred acres and said negrow woman Harriet with her issue at the death of said Annis E Matthews are to be the property of the issue of said Annis E Matthews Body

I constitute, nominate & appoint Rev Samuel James Executrix conjointly with N.M. Graham Executors of this my last will & Testament I give them full power to Execute the same also full power & authority to divided & give off to each of my Hiers theirs parte or share of my estate heretofore mentioned without apling to any corte for a division & any division they may make shall stand final & Deswived
