3rd I wish my Niece Jane M. Miller to have all the Ballance of my house hold Furniture, my Sulkey & harness;

4th all the Ballance of my Estate I wish to be Divided between my four Nieces and Nephew (Viz) Sarah McConnell, Jane M. Miller Catharine Gordon, Rachel Camren, and John H. McConnell share & share alike, (except) I have a Note against Sam^l and George McConnell, the amount of the principal of Said Note (Say one hundred & Thirty dollars) I wish to be Reducted out of John H. McConnell and Rachel Camrens part; & lastly, I do hereby Nominate and appoint my Two Nephews George McConnell son of James McConnell and John Miller Executors to this my last will & Testament, and I do hereby disannul & Make void all former Wills & Testaments, and do hereby declare this; & this only, to be my last will & Testament, in witness where of, I have here unto Set my hand & seal, this first day of April In the Year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred & Twenty four, and in the forty eighth of American Independance.
