and tupal o bay one Acre one half of the corn and fodder tow  
thirds of the stock and one half of the money after the debts  
is paid and the house and furniture all the rest and residue  
of my estat goods and chattels I give and bequeath to my  
dear beloved Son Richardson Monroe Feagin whom I nominate  
Daniel  
constitute and appoint McClam executor of this my last will  
and testament hereby revoking all other and former wills by me a  
at any time heretofore made in witness where of I have unto  
Set my hand and seal the 14 of February 1842 in the year of  
our lord signed Sealed published and declared by the said  
testator Richardson Feagin as and for his last will and test-  
ament in the presence of us who, have subscribed our names  
as witnesses there to in the presence of the Said testator
