- 3 Item I give to my brother Eleazar Morris thrity dollars to be paid to him annually during his life time & should his wife survive him, then thirty dollars I give to his wife, Elizabeth to be paid to hir Yearly during her life.
- 4 It is my desire, & Request of my Executors that neither William Howard, or John Howard or William Cantley shall be imployed or have any authority to superintend or Manige any part of my estate or have any intercourse in or abount my premises
