ROBERT MORRIS.

In the name of God Amen. I Robert Morris of the State of South Carolina Williamsburgh District planter, being in health of body & of sound mind memory & understanding, praised be to God for the same, do make this my last Will & Testament in manner following

1 Item, I give & devise to my beloved Wife one Negro woman named Mela, one Horse named talton, one Gig with harness two Cows & calves, ~~and~~ ten head Hogs, one bed & furniture one third part of my Household & Kitchen furniture also one third part of my Land, ~~and~~ during the term of her natural life, & at her death all the above named is to go to my two sons, Robert Frances Asbury, & Samuel Wesley,

2 Item I give & devise to my two sons, named above, all the Rest residue & Remainder of my Real & personal Estate to be equally divided between them at the age of twenty one Years or Marriage. but in Case either of them should die before he arrives to twenty one Years of age or Marriage then his part is to return to the surviving brother.

3 Item I give to my brother Eleazar Morris thrity dollars to be paid to him annually during his life time & should his wife survive him, then thirty dollars I give to his wife, Elizabeth to be paid to hir Yearly during her life.

4 It is my desire, & Request of my Executors that neither William Howard, or John Howard or William Cantley shall be imployed or have any authority to superintend or Manige any part of my estate or have any intercourse in or about my premises

5 Lastly I constitute nominate & appoint William Burrows Jun. & Willis Godwin Executors of this my last will & testament, giving each of them full power to execute the same, also full power also
