I Robert Gamble of the District aforesaid being sick & low in Body but of sound mind & memory calling to mind the frailty of my nature & knowing that it is appointed for all Men to die I think proper to publish this my last will & testament in manner & form following Viz. First I give and bequeath to my only son James Gamble all my Estate both real & personal after my legal debts are paid to him & his heirs forever-except twenty five dollars which sum I will to John McClary in consideration of my friendship for him. this sum to be paid him within twelve months after my decease-----I hereby revoke all former Wills & bequeath of what kind soever & hereby constitute & ordain my son Gamble aforesaid & my nephew James Burgefs Executors of this my last Will & testament-----  
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this fifth day of December 1809
