In the name of God Amen I Samuel Eddy of South Carolina and Williamsburgh District being very sick and weak of bedy but of perfect mind and memory thanks be to God for the same calling to mind that it is once appointed for all men to die do make this my last will and testament that is to say principally and first of all I give and recommend my soul to God and my body to the earth to be buried in a human christian like manner and as for such worldly Estate as God has blessed me with I give demise and dispose of in manner and form following first it is my desire that my just debts and funeral expenses be paid I also give and bequeath to my daughter Jenny Eddy all my stock of cattle except one Oxen one feather bed and furniture during her natural life and at her death to go back to James A Eddy children Marget D Eddy, Elisabeth M Eddy Samuel I Eddy and Frances Eddy also I give my grandchildren above named one oxen forever also I give to Samuel I Eddy my shot Gun forever also I give to my grandson James M Eddy my set of shoe makers tools forever also I give to my son James A Eddy one feather bed together with all my household Furniture and plantation tooks forever whom I likewise constitute make and appoint the sole Executor of this my last will and testament and I do hereby uterly disallow revoke and disannul all and every other former testaments wills legacies bequeaths and Executors by me in any wise before named ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will and testament.
