First of all I give and recommend my Soul unto god who gave it and concerning my body I recommend it to the earth to be in a decent and Christian like manner hoping for a glorious Resurrection to obtain Ever lasting happiness in the life to come through through the merits and meditates of my Blessed redeemer Jesus Christ and to Such Worldly Estate that god has blessd me with in this life I do hereby give and bequeath the Whole of my Estate both Real and personal to my Beloved Wife Mary Jones and I do hereby Nomenate and Appoint My Beloved Wife Mary Jones Whole and Sole Executrix to this my last will and testament to act and transact as she shall think proper.
