same, do make this my last will and testament, in manner and
form following: I will and bequeath to my Brother Robert
Strong all my Estate real and personal and if he should die
without lawfull issue, then my will is that my said estate be
equally divided between ^{the children} of my sister Elenor Boyd. and I
do nominate constitute and appoint Robert Strong. Hugh Boyd,
John Scott Junr Executors of this my last will and testament
and do declare this to be my last will and testament. In
witness whereof I the said Samuel Strong ^{have} hereunto sett my
hand and seal this fourteenth day of November in the year of
our Lord one thousand eight hundred and nineteen and in the
forty third and fourth years of the Independence of the
