{ I Sarah Salters, of the State and

District aforesaid, being weak and feeble in body but of sound mind and memory, Knowing that it is appointed for all once to die, do hereby make, ordain, constitute and declare this instrument of writing to be and contain my last will and testament, revoking all others heretofore made-----

I recommend my soul unto God from whom I received it, and that my body may be buried with a decent funeral at the descretion of my Executors----- As it respects the worldly goods with which it has pleased my beneficent Creator to bless me, I give bequeath and dispose of in the following manner Viz--

I give and bequeath unto my beloved son John A. Salters and his lawful issue, the following Negroe Slaves, together with all their increase which may thereafter accrue viz Big Mariah, Billy, Ben, Minda, Sally, George, Ceasar, Dina, Ann-itta and Tom---- I also give and bequeath unto my said son John A. Salters and his lawful issue all the land or real Estate of What description Soever----- of which I may die possessed---- I also give and bequeath unto my Said son John A. Salters all my Stock of Horses, Hogs, Cattle and Sheep, with all my plantation tools and Household and Kitchen furniture

I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Elizabeth Adeline Montgomery and the lawful issue of her body the following Negroe Slaves, together with all the issue thereof which May hereafter accrue viz Lizatt, Nanny, Tenah, Joe, Little Mariah, and Lisbon

I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Margaret

do hereby make, ordain, constitute and declare this instrument of writing to be and contain my last will and testament, revoking all others heretofore made-----

I recommend my soul unto God from whom I received it, and that my body may be buried with a decent funeral at the descretion of my Executors----- As it respects the worldly goods with which it has pleased my beneficent Creator to bless me, I give bequeath and dispose of in the following manner Viz--

I give and bequeath unto my beloved son John A. Salters and his lawful issue, the following Negroe Slaves, together with all their increase which may thereafter accrue viz Big Mariah, Billy, Ben, Minda, Sally, George, Ceasar, Dina, Annilla and Tom---- I also give and bequeath unto my said son John A. Salters and his lawful issue all the land or real Estate of what description soever----- of which I may die possessed---- I also give and bequeath unto my said son John A. Salters all my Stock of Horses, Hogs, Cattle and Sheep, with all my plantation tools and Household and Kitchen furniture

I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Elizabeth Adeline Montgomery and the lawful issue of her body the following Negroe Slaves, together with all the issue thereof which may hereafter accrue viz Lizatt, Nanny, Tenah, Joe, Little Mariah, and Lisbon

I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Margaret Emma Watson during her natural life and to her lawful <sup>issue</sup> provided she leave said lawful issue, the following Negroe Slaves together with all their increase which may hereafter accrue viz Big Phillis Charlottes Oscar Carolina, Little Phillis, Bob, and Fortune-----

Should my said daughter Margaret Emma Watson die without leaving lawful issue of her body, it is my will that the above

named Negroes Big Phillis, Charllotte, Oscar, Carolina, Little Phillis Bob and Fortune with all their increase shall return to my son John A. Saltern and my daughter Elizabeth Adeline Montgomery, Share and Share alike Viz One half to my Son John A Saltern and his lawful issue and the other half to my daughter Elizabeth Adeline Montgomery and her lawful issue

Lastly I do hereby Constitute and appoint my beloved Son John A Saltern together with my Sons inlaw John Watson and Henry Montgomery Executors of this my last Will and testament In WitneSs whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this 9th day of May in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight Hundred and Forty and in the Sixty fourth year of American Independence
