I give to my brother William Purse Sen^r my house in Boundary street ----- ^{Stur} I give to my son Thomas Day Singleton Sen^r all my Bank stock or shares in the following Banks Viz The Union Bank, The Planters and Mechanics Bank and the South Carolina Bank.

Item I give to my Son Thomas Day Singleton Sen^r all my Negroes Viz my wench Rose and her children John, Julius, Tony, Rose and Sally together with their, ^{increase} during his natural life and after his decease It is my will that the said negroes Rose and her Children John, Julius, Tony, Rose and Sally together with their increase, become the property of my two Grand-daughters Esther Gibson Singleton and Mary Magdalen BurgeSs Singleton and the issue of their body --- and if either of my two Granddaughters Esther Gibson Singleton or Mary Magdalen BurgeSs Singleton should die before marriage, then the survivor to take the share of the deceased ---- Item I also give to my son Thomas Day Singleton Sen^r all the rest of my personal Estate, and hereby constitute and appoint him Exeoutor to this my last Will and Testament --
