SOLOMON RHODUS

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In the Name of God Amen--I Solomon Rhodus of Williamsburgh
County State of South Carolina being very sick and weak in Body;
but of Sound mind and Memory, thanks be given to God, and Call-
ing to mind the Mortality of the Body and knowing that it is
appointed for all Mankind to die, do make and ordain this my la-
st will and testament--And first I desire that at my death,
my Body be decently Interred at the discretion of my Executors
(Hereafter to be named) nothing doubting but at the General
Resurrection to Receive the same againe by the Mighty power of
God, and my Immortal Soul I Recommend to mercy of my dear
Redeemer and Savior Jesus Christ-- And as for such worldly
Goods as it hath pleased God to Bless me with in this life, I
Give devise and dispose of them in the manner and form follow-
ing And first I desire and order that every part of this my will/
be strictly executed as far as can be done by my Executors and
that all my Just Debts be fully paid and satisfied as soon as
may be after my Decease--and that the several legacies Hereafter
to be mentioned be all paid and satisfied agreeable to the Re-
strictions below--Item, It is my will, that out of my Estate my
Brother William Rhodus or his heirs be paid five Shillings as a
Remembrance of Brotherly love and affection if called for within
twelve months after my death--And to the Heirs of my Brother
Nathaniel I Give Five Shillings on the same consideration, And
to the Heirs of my Brother Daniel I Give the sum of Five Shill-
ings, And to the Heirs of my Brother John I Give the sum of
Five Shillings, And to the Heirs of my Sister Mary Howard I Give
the sum of Five Shillings, And to my Sister Ann Perrett, I Give
the like sum of Five Shillings--And likewise to the Heirs of my

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Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
seal the 18th of Septemeber one thousand eight Hundred four
in the 28 and 29 year of the sovereignty and Independence of
the United States of America

Resurrection to Receive the same againe by the Mighty power of God, and my Immortal Soul I Recommend to mercy of my dear Redeemer and Savior Jesus Christ-- And as for such worldly Goods as it hath pleased God to Bless me with in this life, I Give devise and dispose of them in the manner and form following And first I desire and order that every part of this my will be strictly executed as far as can be done by my Executors and that all my Just Debts be fully paid and satisfied as soon as may be after my Decease--and that the several legacies Hereafter to be mentioned be all paid and satisfied agreeable to the Restrictions below--Item, It is my will, that out of my Estate my Brother William Rhodus or his heirs be paid five Shillings as a Remembrance of Brotherly love and affection if called for within twelve months after my death--And to the Heirs of my Brother Nathaniel I Give Five Shillings on the same consideration, And to the Heirs of my Brother Daniel I Give the sum of Five Shillings, And to the Heirs of my Brother John I Give the sum of Five Shillings, And to the Heirs of my Sister Mary Howard I Give the sum of Five Shillings, And to my Sister Ann Perrett, I Give the like sum of Five Shillings--And likewise to the Heirs of my Sister Patience Hill, I Give the like sum of Five Shillings, Which legacies it is my desire shall be paid out of my Estate Within one year after my decease if called for--And if not called for in the time mentioned not to be paid at all--And all the Rest of my Estate both real and personal I Give wholly and solely to my Beloved Wife Nancy Rhodus to her and her Heirs forever And I do hereby Constitute my Beloved Wife Nancy to be my only and sole Executrix of this my last will and testament--Hereby Revokeing and annulling and making void all former Wills by me made--Declaring this and no other to be my last Will and
