First I commit my body to the Earth and my s oul to The almighty, God, Resting in the hope of mercy Through the merrit and Mediation of Christ our saviour, I Desire my Funeral expences And my Just and lawfull Debts to be first paid, I Give and bequeath To my Brothers Peter Owens and Sister Mary Hanna and Sister Amma Johnson and Sister Ann Haselden and Sister Elizabeth Haseldin And Sister Jane Price, All my Real and personal propperty to be Equally divided among the above mentioned named--Except one Shilling to be Given to the heirs of my Brother--Nacesiah Owens De^d and to James Hanna husband of Sister Lucy D^{ead} and his heirs and and to Edward Johnfon husband of Sister Amma above mentioned and his heirs I also Desire that Sister Amma Johnfons part should rist in the Possession of Brother Peter Owens and for her to receive it As he thinks most propper, And I do hereby Nominate And appoint my Brother Peter Owens and samuel Haselden And John Haselden and John Price of Williamsburgh District Sole Executors to this my last will and Testament Signed Sealed this Twenty 1 day of April in the Year of our lord one thousand Eight hundred and Eight

Observe in the thirteenth and forteenth lines two words Impropper was Macd.. out and others entered before Signed
