I Susannah Mouzon Widow of Williamsborough District Being weak and lame of Body but Perfect mind and memory, do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say First I give and bequeath to my three Sons, Peter, William & Samuel R. Mouzon, and my two Daughters Sarah Gamble and Mary McGill one Dollar each I give and Bequeth to my three Single Children Ann Mouzon, Susannah V. Mouzon & Henry V. Mouzon all my Right and claim of Dower of in on to all the Lands which my Deceased Husband has been Intitled to Since our marriage, also my Negro Woman Cate my Riding chair and Harnefs all my Stock of Horses, Cattle & Hogs, to be divided equally between them Share and Share alike to them and their Heirs for ever-----Lastly I nominate Constitute and appoint my Son Samuel R. Mouzon and my Son in law James McGill Executors to this my last Will and Testment. In Witnefs whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this 19 day of ~~March~~ 1817-----
