South Carolina } I Thomas G Britton planter in the
Williamsburgh District } District aforesaid I make and ordain
this to be my last will and Testament 1st. I give and bequeath
to my loving wife Margaret Britton all of the property both real
and personal which I got by her in marriage to be at her own
disposal also a stock of Cattle now in Brittons Neck and all
the money due me from the Estate of Elizabeth Woodbury deceased
now in the hands of William Woodbury in trust for her full share
of all my whole Estate both real and personal it being an agree-
ment between us before our marriage the above maid upon the
express condition that they be in Law of dower to which she
would by law may be Entitled-----2nd. I have by Loan to my
daughter Mary Martin during her lifetime the six following
Negroes named Jenny Bett sersaly Little Stephen little Peter
and Plenty with the future increase of the females also my
plantation Known by the name of Brittons Ferry on the Pee dee,
with the Magrigar tract---joining below also my rate of the
land that Inex above adjoining the ferry tract none as the
Claples Lake tract at her risk the above mentioned property I
have valued at ninteen hundred and twenty five dollars 3^d I
hereby loan to my Daughter Sarah G Britton during her life time
the five following negroes Phill Judy Silla Sam and Isaac with
the future increase of the females also one feather bed and
furniture the above negroes valued at fourteen hundred dollars
also I give to my Daughter Sarah G Britton three tracts of Land
two tracts of the above mentioned lying in Williamsburgh Distr-
ict on the east and west side of clarks creek also the other

and personal which I got by her in marriage to be at her own disposal also a stock of Cattle now in Brittons Neck and all the money due me from the Estate of Elizabeth Woodbury deceased now in the hands of William Woodbury in trust for her full share of all my whole Estate both real and personal it being an agreement between us before our marriage the above maid upon the express condition that they be in Law of dower to which she would by law may be Entitled-----2nd. I have by Loan to my daughter Mary Martin during her lifetime the six following Negroes named Jenny Bett versaly Little Stephen little Peter and plenty with the future increase of the females also my plantation Known by the name of Brittons Ferry on the Pee dee, with the Magrigar tract---joining below also my rate of the land that Inex above adjoining the ferry tract none as the Charles Lake tract at her risk the above mentioned property I have valued at ninteen hundred and twenty five dollars 3^d. I hereby loan to my Daughter Sarah G Britton during her life time the five following negroes Phill Judy Silla Sam and Isaac with the future increase of the females also one feather bed and furniture the above negroes valued at fourteen hundred dollars also I give to my Daughter Sarah G Britton three tracts of Land two tracts of the above mentioned lying in Williamsburgh District on the east and west side of clarks creek also the other tracts lying in Georgetown Destrict as the plat will more fully show, the above Land valued at four hundred dollars 4th. I do hereby loan to my son Thomas N. Britton during his lifetime the following named Negroes Stephen fanny Patty and England with the future increase of the females also one half of the tact of Land purchased from Benjamin Britton the above land and negroes valued at eighteen hundred and thirty five dollars----- 5th. I do hereby loan to my son John F. D. Britton during his life the
