should
My wish is that my land shall remain unoccupied until my Chil-
dren may wish to occupy it or until the youngest arrives to
the years of twenty one I wish my children Supported and edu-
cated from ~~the~~ ^{my} money and as they arrive to the age of twenty
one each to receive their full part or share of money I here-
by appoint John Tisdale Samuel Tisdale and Thomas Steele my
father the sole executors of this my last will and testament
hereby revoking all former wills by me made. In witneSs where-
of I have set my hand and Seal this 10 day of February in the
year of our Lord one thousand ^{eight hundred} and thirty nine
