WILLIAM BUFORD

State of South Carolina-----

I William Buford of Williamburgh District, in the State aforesaid (Planter) do make and ordain this Instrument of writing an addition or codicil to my last Will and testament executed by me on the twenty fifth instant that is to say----- I give and bequeath to my Grandson Peter Fraser son of the Rev^d Hugh Fraser an equal share of my Estate both real & personal with the rest of my children mentioned in my said Will; that is to say the one fifth part of my said estate, to him and his heirs forever --- It is my Will and desire that my Executors mentioned in said will do convey by Deed to Mrs Elizabeth Gour^{dine} dine wife of Theodore Esq^r & to there children and to there heirs the following Property purchased by me for them Viz. All that plantation in sundry Tracts butting & bounding to the south on Santee River West on lands the Estate of Peter Porcher North on lands claimed by the heirs of Henry Mouzon, East on ~~xx~~ lands of the said Henry Mouzon the estate of John Fitzgerald and my ownlands, on which I live, the same being purchased by me at Sheriffs Sales, Also one other Plantation in sundry tracts situated on santee river in the Election district of Williamsburg and State afor said, containing one Thousand acres more or less, butting and bounding south wardly on Santee River Westwardly on lands of John Fitzgerald William Buford & ^{of} the estate of Henry Mouzon Jun^r northwardly on lands of the said estate & the estate of Abraham Perrett, & eastwardly on lands of William Laws, & the estate of Peter June, purchased by me ~~xx~~

by me on the ~~twenty fifth~~ instant that is to say----- I give

from Robert Francis Withers of the election district of Win-
yaw in the state aforesaid Also that portion of the plantation
or tract of land on which I now live on, being the Western
part of my said plantation agreeable to a platte ^{thereof} made by
William H. Mouzon surveyor or adjoining Red Clay Plantation
extended so as to include the spring branch on which the dam
is as far as the said Platt there of reference thereto being
had will more fully appear--- Which said several Plantations
or sundry Tracts of lands in my particular Will wish & desire

should be conveyed by my Executors as aforesaid to Mrs Elizabeth Gourdine Gourdine & her children reserving to myself that part of the plantation purchased of Robert Francis Withers which was lade off by William H Mounson surveyor as tax per Platt thereof will more fully appear, also provided that my Bond given to the said Robert Francis Withers for four hundred Pounds with Interest be fully discharged and paid by Theodore Gourdine Esq^r In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty seventh day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ten-----
