In the name of God Amen, I William Friereson ⁸¹ of Williamsburgh
 District in the State of South Carolina planter, being in health
 of Body, and of Sound and disposing minde, memory and under-
 standing, praised be God for the Same, do make this my last
 will and Testament, in the manner and form following (That is
 to say) First, It is my will and desire that my Executors do
 pay all my Just and lawful debts, Also that they erect a tomb
 stone at the head of my grave, descriptive of my age, and time
 of my death, with some suitable lines or matters at their dis-
 cretion, Item I give and bequeath unto my Grandson William
 Friereson Rodgers the whole of my real and personal Estate, it
 is my will and desire that my Executors keep up the plantation
 which I now occupy and reside on, and to employ from time to
 time some humane person as an overseer to manage and superentend
 the negroes, planting Interest and stock on the same,
 Item It is my will and desire that my Grandson be educated
 and supported out of the proceeds of the farm, and whatever,
 money I may have in hand or at interest at the time of my death
~~Item It is my Will and desire that if my Grandson William Friereson~~
 Friereson Rodgers should die before he arrives at the age of Twenty
 One years, or marries, then in that case it is my will and de-
 sire, that if my Brother Samuel Friereson who resides in the
 State of Alabama be then alive that he receives the sum of
 two hundred dollars, Item it is my Will and desire also that
 my one yard with all the apparatus appertaining there to be
 vested in my two friends William Liffage Jr and Joseph Chandler
 Item and lastly, as to all the rest, residue, and remainder of
 my real and personal Estate, goods and chattels of what kind

Item and lastly, as to all the rest, residue, and remainder of my real and personal Estate goods and chattles of what kind

and nature soever, I give and bequeath the same unto Bonister Sister; Children shall claim their fathers part Susannah A.

Frierson Daniel Frierson and the living children of my Brothers Joshua and George Friersons in the State of Tennessee, to

be equally divided between them, it is my will and desire that if any of my above named or described Nephews or Neices should

die, that their part or parts be equally divided among the

survivors - and my express Will and meaning is and I do hereby order and appoint that if any difference, dispute, or controversy shall arise or happen, concerning any gift or bequeath in this my last Will and Testament given or bequeathed, that no suit, or suits in law or Equity, or otherwise, shall be brought or prosecuted for the same, but that the same shall be referred wholly to the word order and determination of five disinterested and Judicious neighbours to be chosen by my Executors, and what they shall order, direct or determine there in, shall be binding and conclusive, to all and every person and persons concerned therein --- And I do hereby nominate and appoint, my worthy friends Henry D. Shaw, William Liffage Jr. and Joseph Chandler Executors to this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking forever all former Wills by me made, In witness whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal this Ninth day of September in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty and in the fifty fourth year of the American Independence
