In the Name of God Amen. I William H. Gamble of the district of Williamsburgh and State of South Carolina do make and constitute this my last will and Testament in Manner & form following. 1st I give and bequeath unto my beloved Mother Sarah Gamble a Negro boy Moses and all of my Stock of Cattle during her Natural life at her death I wish the said boy Moses & my said Stock of cattle to be equally divided Among the children of my sister Adelaid D. Daky & the other half of my said stock of cattle to be equally divided among the children of my sister Mary McClary- 2- I give & bequeath unto my Brother Robert Gamble & his Children the plantation or tract of land whereon my Mother now resides containing thirteen hundred & twenty five acres more or less for the use & support of my said Brother & their family during the natural life & not to be subject to any debt or debts contracted by my said Brother, and at his death to be equally divided among his children 3 I give and bequeath unto my brother James Gamble my boy Lymus and Gun for the use and support of my said Brother this family during the natural life of my said Brother & not to be subject to any debt or debts contracted by him & at his death to be equally divided among his children. 4 I give and bequeath unto my sister Jane Tisdale during his natural life <sup>my</sup> negro Girl Peggy and her future increase at the death of my said sister the Girl Peggy with her increase to be equally divided among my said sisters Children- 5 I give and bequeath unto my sister Elizabeth Tisdale during her natural life my negro woman Caroline & boy Jacob, at the death of my said sister to be equally divided among her children 6 I t is my will and desire that my boy Jim be sold by my

Gamble a Negro boy Moses and all of my Stock of Cattle during her Natural life at her death I wish the said boy Moses & my said Stock of cattle to be equally divided Among the children of my sister Adelaid D. Daky & the other half of my said stock of cattle to be equally divided among the children of my sister Mary McClary- 2- I give & bequeath unto my Brother Robert Gamble & his Children the plantation or tract of land whereon my Mother now resides containing thirteen hundred & twenty five acres more or less for the use & support of my said Brother & their family during the natural life & not to be subject to any debt or debts contracted by my said Brother, and at his death to be equally divided among his children

3 I give and bequeath unto my brother James Gamble my boy Lymus and Gun for the use and support of my said Brother this family during the natural life of my said Brother & not to be subject to any debt or debts contracted by him & at his death to be equally divided among his children.

4 I give and bequeath unto my sister Jane Tisdale during his natural life <sup>my</sup> negro Girl Peggy and her future increase at the death of my said sister the Girl Peggy with her increase to be equally divided among my said sisters Children-

5 I give and bequeath unto my sister Elizabeth Tisdale during her natural life my negro woman Caroline & boy Jacob. at the death of my said sister to be equally divided among her children

6 I t is my will and desire that my boy Jim be sold by my <sup>and</sup> Executor herein after named all of my just debts be paid by the money arising from said sale. and that my Executor detain in his hand one hundred Dollars for the use of my sister Matilda Brown & her children & not to be subject to the debts or contract of Jamy L. Brown her husband but to purchase for my said sister may think best & whatever money may still be in the hand

of my E\_xecutor after paying my debts & giving my sister Matilda Brown the said one hundred dollarate br paid over to my Mother f for her own separate use

Lastly I do hereby appoint my friend John I Tisdale my Executor to this my last will & testament--In testimony where of I have here to set my hand & seal in presence of these presents this twenty eight day of Sept Anno Domini One Thousand Eight hundred and forty Seven.
