garle by the name of mender to him and his heirs forever I  
also give and bequeath to my son William Johnsons children  
at my decease one negro garle by the name of Sary to them  
and thare heirs forEver I also give and bequeath to my two  
grand daughters Caroline Johnson and Rebecca Johnson at my  
decease one hundred dollars a pease to be paid to them as  
soon as it is convenient to be Rased to them and thare heirs  
forEver and after all my Just Debts and Expences be paid  
I Lend unto my wife Celia during her life time the free and  
undisturbed use of all my Lands plantation and houses house-  
hold and Kitchen furniture horses Stook of all kinds cash in  
hand in short all and Every part of my Real and personal Estate  
that I may Die posessed of Except what I have Devised to my  
grand children all Ready and at hir decease I Divise that my  
Executors Do advirtise and Sell and Equally divide all my  
Estate between My Children and Ther heirs and I also make  
nominate Constitute and appoint my beLoved Sun Frances John-  
son sole Executor of this my Last will and testament, hereby  
revoking and making Void all and Every other will and wills at  
any time here to fore by me made and Do declare this to be my  
Last will and testament in witness where of I have here unto
