In the Name of God Amen. I William McConnell of the District of Williamsburgh and State of South Carolina duly considering the mortal Condition of human Nature that all men are appointed once to die and that it is necessary to be prepared for that event I do therefore after ~~the~~ recommending my soul to God through the mercies of the redeemer make the following arrangement and distribution of my temporal estate as follows, Item 1st It is my wish that my Negrofellow Moses should be sold to pay all my just debts and funeral expenses Item 2nd. I will and bequeath to my beloved wife Margaret the use of all my Lands and Houses together with with six Negroes namely Cain, Peg, Peter, Charlott, Jennet and Ned, with their future increase also my horsas and Chair stock, of black Cattle and hogs household kitchen furniture and plantation tools, her life time and at her death it is my wish that the property be divided as follows. Item 3rd. I will and bequeath to my son william Gibson, my silver watch, Item 4th. I will and bequeath to my daughter Mary Bradley, the sum of ~~xx~~ Teen dollars Item 5... I will and bequeath to my daughter Ann Elizabeth one Bed and furniture and also battle which she Claims. Item 6th.. I will and bequeath to my daughter Frances Jane, one Bed and furniture and also battle which she Claims, Item 7th..I will and bequeath to my son Robert Franklin one bow and half which he also claims Item 8th... I will and bequeath to Femala Hamilton one Bed and furniture, this is all that I leave to my first wife^s Children and after they receive what I have willed to them it is my wish that all the remaining part of my estate consisting of

I will and bequeath to my daughter Frances Jane, one bed and furniture and also battle which she Claims, Item 7th.. I will and bequeath to my son Robert Franklin one bow and half which he also claims Item 8th... I will and bequeath to Pamela Hamilton one bed and furniture, this is all that I leave to my first wife's Children and after they receive what I have willed to them it is my wish that all the remaining part of my estate consisting of Negroes Lands houses household Kitchen furniture plantation tools stock of horses battle hogs &c shall be equally divided by my ~~Exor~~ as they think most convenient between my last Wives Children and Pamela Hamilton so that they share and share alike and lastly I do hereby anominate and appoint my beloved Wife Exetrix and my son William Gibson ~~Exor~~^F of this my last Will and testament hereby Revoking all former Wills made by me and declare this to be my last Will and testament this twenty third day of January ~~in the year of our Lord one thousand eight~~
