Also one Negroe fellow named Daniel, one Negro Wench named Sarah, a boy named Dick, & a boy named Prince which said Negroes I do bargain & sell as above to the said John Peoples his Heirs & Assigns as Witness my Hand this 2^d Day of June 1789.

To all to whom these presents shall come I Daniel Bourdeaux of Charleston in the state aforesaid, Esquire send Greeting Whereas I the said Daniel Bourdeaux by my Bond or Obligation bearing even Date with these presents stand bound and obliged unto Charles Prince of Charleston aforesaid Esquire & Ann his Wife administratrix with the Will annexed of all and singular the Goods and Chattels Rights and Credits which were of Clement Lompriere of the state aforesaid Esquire Deceased in the Penal sum of Three Thousand Three Hundred & sixty pounds sterling money with a condition thereunder written for the payment of the sum of one thousand six Hundred and Eighty pounds like money, to be paid, unto the said Charles Prince and Ann his wife administratrix aforesaid at the time & manner therein mentioned their Heirs, Executors, Administrators, or Assigns as in and by the said bond or Obligation and Condition thereunder written (Relation thereunto being had) doth more fully and at large appear. NOW KNOW YE, That I the said Daniel Bourdeaux for the better securing the payment of the said sum of one Thousand six Hundred and Eighty pounds unto the said Charles Prince & Ann his Wife as Administratrix aforesaid their Heirs, Executors, Administrators, or Assigns together with Lawfull Interest for the same, according to the Condition of the said Bond have Bargained and sold, and by these presents do Bargain and sell, and in plain and Open Market Deliver unto the said Charles Prince and ^{Ann} his wife as Administratrix aforesaid the following Negro Slaves to wit, Old Nancy, Barr, Tibb, Jacob, Jane, Tony, Maria, Moses, Paula, Mary, Bess, Molly, Binah, Charles, Pymon, Charlotte, Catty, Betty, Will, Patt, Merom, Adam, Capou, Beck, Old Jack, Younger Jack, Patt, Old Hector, Marlborough, Diana, Charlotte, Leah, Cuffee, Cato, Haggar, Rachell, York, Jack TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Negro Slaves together with the future Issue & increase of the said females unto the said Charles Prince & Ann his Wife as Administratrix aforesaid their Executors Administrators and Assigns forever, Provided always nevertheless That if the said Daniel Bourdeaux or his Heirs, Executors, or Administrators shall and do well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Charles Prince & Ann his Wife
