Southwell the Receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge I have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain sell deliver to the said Sary Southwell a Negro boy Named Solomon to have and hold the said boy Solomon unto the said Sary Southwell her Executors Administrators and Assigns to her and her only proper use and behoof for ever and I the said Jeremiah Joyner my heirs Executors and Administrators the said Assigns from and against all persons so and will warrant and for ever defend by these presents In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal dated on the 1st Day of May in the Eleventh Year of our Independence and in the year of our Lord
