be buried at the discretion of my Executors. Thirdly I give & dispose
of all my Worldly goods in manner & form Following
Item I give & bequeath to my well beloved Wife Sarah South
well all my Household furniture to be for Use during her Lifetime
after her Decease to equally divided between my three Sons and my
Daughter Mary Southwell Item I give & bequeath to my well
beloved Wife Sarah Southwell all my Stock of Cattle during
her natural Life, & after her Decen to be equally divided between
my three Sons Edward, John, William & my Daughter Mary South
well & this I leave as my last Will & Testament, revoking & disallow
ing all former Wills & this I acknowledge & set my Hand & Seal
affix my Seal in the Presence of these Witnesses & I leave my
Wife & my Son Edward Southwell to be my Executors
