

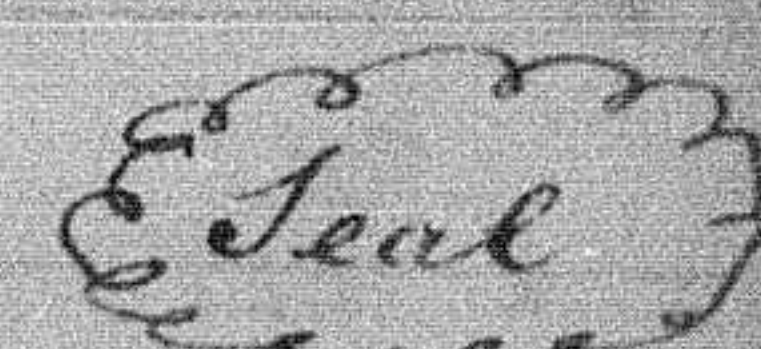

deration of the Love, good Will and Affection which I have & do
bare toward my loving Son Daniel Collins, of the State and
County aforesaid, have given & granted, & by these presents
do freely give & grant, unto the said Daniel Collins his Heirs
Executors or Administrators a certain Tract of Land containing
one, ^{hundred} and fifty Acres that he the said James Collins bought
of Thomas Morris in the County and State aforesaid, & likewise
for the Love, good Will & Affection, which I have & do bare toward
my loving Daughter Mary Collins, of the State & County afores.
have granted & by these presents, do freely give and grant unto
the said Mary Collins, her Heirs Executors or Administrators a certain
Negro Girl named Violet, of which before the signing of these
presents Deliverd him the said Daniel Collins, her the said
Mary Collins an Inventory Signd with my own hand, bearing
even Date, to have & to have and to hold, the said Land & Negro
girl, to them the s^d Daniel Collins & Mary Collins, their Heirs
Executors Administrators from henceforth, as their property abso-
lutely without any manner of condition, only if the said Negro
Girl should have any Children, they are to be at the Dispo-
sal ~~of~~ of the said James Collins, in Witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand & Seal, this 5th Day of August
one, ^{thousand} seven hundred and eighty eight.
