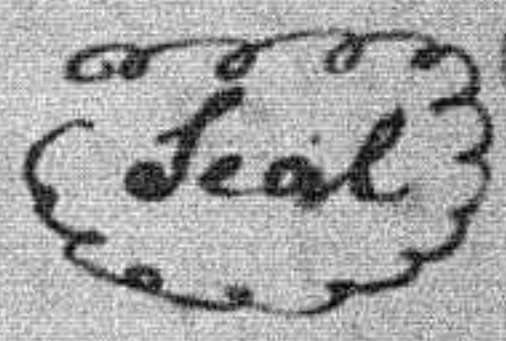

hereby bargain & sell & deliver to the said Walter Robin-
son three Negroe Slaves York, Hagar & Child to have &
to hold the three Slaves with the future increase to the
said Walter Robinson his Executors, administrators
& assigns to his & their only proper use & behoof for-
ever. & I the said Will^m Brown for my Self & my Heirs
Executors Administrators & assigns from & against all
persons shall & will Warrant & for ever defend by these
presents in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
Hand & Seal Dated at Savannah on the fourth
Day of November in the Year of our Lord one thou-
sand seven hundred & eighty eight

five pounds to us in hand paid at & before the selling &
delivory of these presents by Walter Robinson Planter
of said County the receipt whereof we do hereby ac-
knowledge have bargained & sold & by these presents
do bargain & sell & deliver unto the said Walter
Robinson Planter a Negro Boy named Jem a
bout eleven Years old To have & to hold the said
Jem unto the said Walter Robinson his Executors admi-
nistrators & assigns to his & his only proper use & behoof
for ever. And we the said Owen Odom & John Stuart
for our selves our Heirs Executors and administrators
the said bargained premises unto the said Walter
Robinson his Executors administrators & assigns from
& against all persons shall & will Warrant & for ever
defend by these presents in Witness whereof we
have hereunto set our Hands & Seals Dated at
the White Ponds twenty third Day of May in the
Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred &
eighty nine & the thirteenth Year of the Independance
of the untited States of North America

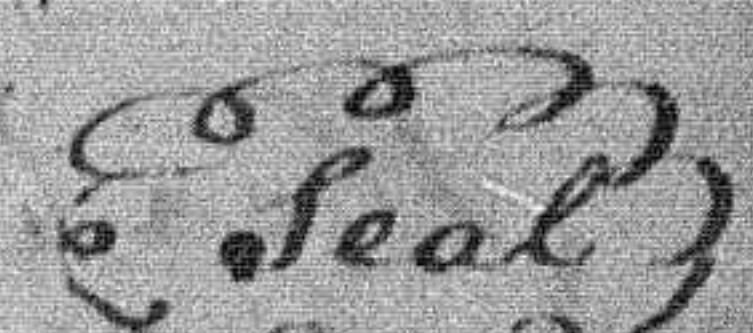
