the said Charles Prince & Ann his Wife as Administratrix aforesaid
their Executors, Administrators and Assigns, by these presents, That if Default
shall happen to be made of or in payment of the said sum of One Thousand
six Hundred and Eighty pounds as aforesaid according to the true Intent
and Meaning of the said Condition, that then and in such case, it shall
and may be Lawfull to and for the said Charles Prince and Ann his wife
as Administratrix aforesaid their Executors, Administrators, Assigns
Attornies, or Agents, from time to time and at all times hereafter, peace-
ably and quietly to enter into any or all the Messuages, Lands or Tenements
of the said Daniel Bourdeaux, and to take the said Negro Slaves toge-
ther with the future Issue & Increase of the said females into their Custody
and Possession, and the same to hold and Detain to their own Use and
Behood (as of their own proper Good and Chattels) from thenceforth
and forever, or the same to sell and Dispose of at their will and pleasure
returning the Overplus if any should happen to be after Paying the
said Sum of One Thousand six Hundred and Eighty pounds with
all Interest due thereon as aforesaid unto the said Charles Prince &
Ann his Wife as Administratrix aforesaid their Executors Administrators
