In the name of God Amen, I Robert Lee of the State aforesaid being very Weak but of perfect Mind and Memory thanks be given unto God for it & knowing it is appointed for all men once to Die & as touching such worldly Estate as has been pleased God to give me in this Life I give dismiss & dispose of the same in the following Manner & form following Vid. — First I give to my well beloved Son Godfrey Lee one Negro Woman named Hannah and her two youngest Children one Girl named Jean and one Boy named Page & all my Lands. I also give to my Grand Daughter Sarah Lee daughter to my Son Lewis Lee one negro Girl named Semimah, and my Grandson Benjamin Odum Lee one negro lad named Bucks with their equal Share of all my moveable Effects & their Negroes to be left with my Executors untill they come of Age, the Executors for the work of said To give their Owners Education, Viz The Boy to be perfectly learned to the Rule of three, The Girl to read & write perfectly. I also give my Daughter Sarah Peoples one Negro Man named Sesar & one negro Girl named Violet, with her equal share of all my moveable Estate Effects I also lend to my Daughter Winifred Blackman her life time one negro Girl named Flagar & after her death to belong to my Granddaughter Zephia Blackman & the Increase of the said Flagar to be divided amongst the Heirs of Body of said Winifred Blackman untill they all get one with an equal part of all my moveable affects. I also give to my well beloved Wife Elizabeth one Grey Gildon & one feather Bed & furniture. I constitute & appoint Henry Peoples Godfrey Lee & George Robison to be my Sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament confessing this and no other to be my last Will & Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand & Seal this 28th of October 1782 Signed, Seald published pronounced & delivered by the said Robert Lee as his last Will & Testament in the presents of us who in his presents & the presents of each other have hereunto subscribed our Names

N.B. the above is hereby confirmed by me Robert Lee to be comply with after my Death and not until then which I under subscribers doth Witness

Carolina & Winton County Farmer, being weakly in Body but of
perfect Mind & Memory, thanks be unto God, calling to mind the Morta-
lity of my Body, & knowing it is appointed for all men once to die
do make and ordain this my last Will & Testament, that is to say, prin-
cipally & first of all, I give & recomend my Soul unto the Hand of
Almighty God who give it & my Body I recomend to the Earth, to be
buried in a decent Christian Burial at the discretion of my Executors
nothing doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive
the same again by the mighty power of God. As touching such
worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me within
this Life. I Give demise, and dispose of the same in the following
manner & form — First. I lend my dearly beloved Wife Susanna
Hankinson Four Negroes Named as follows. Old George. Stepmey.
Old Sesar. & Bess. & likewise I desire that a young likely negro
Boy & Girl shall be bought such as my Wife shall approve
of & lent to her as above directed & likewise I lend the Planta-
tion in Crackers Neck whereon I formerly lived Joining to
Island Creek to my Wife untill my Son Richard Hankinson ar-
rives at the Age of Eighteen Years & if my Son Rich^d Hankinson
should not choose that his Mother should not live on the said
Plantation at the expiration of his Age limited, the s^d Rich^d
Hankinson is to find for his said Mother a decent Place such
as she shall chuse to live upon, or else she may live upon the
said Plantation during her Life or as long as she shall live
unmarried or single Likewise lend her Five Cows & calves
such as she shall chuse out of the Stock, I likewise lend her
one good Bedd & furniture such as she shall chuse & also all
other Furniture as shall be deemed necessary for keeping House
by the others Executors. I likewise lend & order to be found her one
good riding Horse bridle & Saddle such as she shall chuse, I like-
wise lend her six Sows & Piggs, all the above lend Articles at my
Wifes Dece^s to the Estate to be equally divided amongst Children
that is to say. Richard, Sarah, Patsey, & Mary Hankinson, likewise
I desire that my Wife shall keep all my Children above mentioned
untill they arrive to the Years of eighteen that is if she shall
bring them up in a decent Christian Manner. & if she dont I
desire N.B Page 1 Robert Hankinson Seal Desire that the
other Executors will take the Children and board them out & their
Boarding, Clotheing & Schooling to come out of the Estate & like-
wise if she continues a Widow they are to continue with her & she
to be found her lifetime out of the Estate, but if she Marries
