

This Indenture made the twenty ninth Day of July One
thousand seven hundred eighty nine between Sampson
Griffen of the State of South Carolina Planter of the one
part & Willm Minor of the same place Deputy Surveyor of the
other part. Whereas the said Sampson Griffen by his Bond or
Obligation duly executed bearing Date the twenty sixth Day
of July one thousand seven hundred eighty nine standeth
unto the said Willm Minor his Heirs Executors Administrators &c
in the Penal Sum of thirty four pounds fourteen Shillings &
two pence Sterling Money of the State aforesaid with a condition
hereunderwritten for the payment of the sum of Seventeen
pounds seven Shillings & one penny of like Lawful Money
with Legal Interest on the same on or before the first Day
of April one thousand seven hundred ninety as by the s^d
Bond y^e condition may more fully appear. Now this Indenture
Witnesseth that the said Sampson Griffen in consideration of
the said Debt of Seventeen pounds seven Shillings & one penny
owing to the said Willm Minor aforesaid & for the better securing
the Payment thereof with Interest to the said Willm Minor his
Heirs Executors Administrators & Assigns according to the Condition
of the said Bond & also in Consideration of the further Sum
of five Shillings to him the said Sampson Griffen by the said
Willm Minor in hand well & truly paid at or before the Sealing
& delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof the s^d Sampson
Griffen doth hereby acknowledge, doth hereby & therefrom
acquit, Release, Exonerate & forever discharge the said Willm
Minor his Heirs, Executors, Administrators & every of them by
these Presents. Hath Granted, Bargained & Sold & by these
Presents doth Grant, Bargain, & Sell unto the said Willm Minor
his Executors, Administrators, Assigns, One Negroe Woman
Named Hannah & her Child Sall. To have & to hold the said
Negroes before granted Bargained & Sold, or mentioned or in-
tended to be bargained & sold unto the said Willm Minor his
Executors, Administrators, Assigns to the only proper use &
behalf of the said Willm Minor his Executors, Administrators
& Assigns for ever. Provided always these presents are
upon this Condition that if the said Sampson Griffen his
Executors or Administrators, shall and do well & truly pay
or cause to be paid unto the said Willm Minor his Executors.

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Executors, Administrators or Assigns the full sum of
Seventeen pounds seven Shillings & one penny Sterling Money
of the State aforesaid, with Legal Interest thereon by the first
Day of April one thousand seven hundred ninety & in such
case these presents & every Matter & thing herein contained
shall cease, determine & be utterly Void to all intents and
purposes. And the said Willm Minor further Covenants &
agrees to & with the s^d Sampson Griffen that he the said Willm
Minor will Receive from the said Sampson Griffen in Lieu
of the Money herein before mentioned, Cow & Calves at the
Rate of two Pounds fourteen Shillings & four pence half
penny for each Cow & Calf provided that the Cattle are
good & saleable. & the said Sampson Griffen for himself
his Heirs Executors & Administrators & every of them the
said Negroes by these Presents Granted, Bargained & Sold &
each of them to the said Willm Minor his Executors Adm^rs &
Assigns against him the said Griffen his Heirs Executors &
Administrators & against all & every other Person & Persons
whatsoever shall & will Warrant & forever defend by these
Presents In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand
& Seal the Day & Year before Written. —
