for and in consideration of the Natural Love and good Will
I have for my dearly beloved Wife Nancy Collins, I do give
to her and her Heirs for Ever. All that Plantation or Tract
of Land Containing one hundred and fifty Acres, which
I lately purchased of Thomas Morris, situate in Winton
County and State aforesaid, on the East Side of Turkey Creek
the Waters of big Saltcatcher, bounded on Thomas Bannons
Land, and on James Morris Land, yon Nathaniel Saunders
Land, and partly on my other Land. Also one Negro Girl
named Violet, together with her future Increase, to have
and to hold unto the said Nancy Collins & to her & her Heirs
for Ever. & I the said James Collins for my self my Heirs
Executors, Administrators & Assigns, from and against all
Persons Whatsoever, will Warrant & for Ever Defend the
above mentioned Tract of Land, together with the said Negro
Girl and her future Increase, unto the said Nancy Collins
& to her and her Heirs for Ever, in Witness whereof I have
hereunto set my Hand & Seal, this Second Day of
April, in the Year of our Lord One thousand seven
hundred and Eighty Eight —

Padgett, Sarah & Lidea Padgett, James and Edwin and Henry Padgett &
John Altman, the true Heirs of my Body, all of the same State & County,
have given and granted and by these presents do freely give &
Grant, unto the said seven Children abovementioned, their Heirs
Executors & Administrators, all and my ^{singular} goods and Chattles now
being in my Possession, in the County aforesaid, one Negro Man
named Joe, a Negro Wench named Rose, & two Negro Children
named ^{Patt} & the other named ^{Lane} ^{boy} named Jack
thus SP. and one Sorrell Mare, likewise four feather Beds and
furniture, and all my husehold furnitur, of which before the signing
of these presents, I have deliverd to the above seven Children
abovenamed, an Inventory signd with my own hand, & bearing
Date, to have and to hold all the said Goods & Chattles abovementiond,
or in the said premises or Dwelling House, to them the said
their heirs Executors or administrators from thenceforth as their &
their Proper. Goods & Chattles, absolutely without any manner of
Condition, in Witness whereof I have hereunto put my hand, and
Seal this twenty Second Day of December One thousand ^{seven hundred} eighty four
