Roan; Which Cattle & Mares I do Warrant & Defend
from any Person or Persons laying any just right &
Claim, given under my Hand & Seal, this fifteenth
Day of September 1788.

Cannon to Solomon Owens & George Kersh
Know all men by these presents that I Henry Can-
non of Winton County, for & in consideration of the sum
of one hundred Pounds Sterl. to me in hand paid by
Solomon Owens & George Kersh of the said County
Planters. the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge
have bargained sold & delivered, and by these presents
do bargain sell & deliver unto Solomon Owens & George
Kersh for the full & Just sum of one Hundred pounds
Sterling Four Negroes who are named as follows,
Rode her Child China, a Girl Judah, & Violet. to have
& to hold the said bargained premises unto the said
Solomon Owens & George Kersh their Executors
Administrators & assigns, Shall & will Warrant &
defend from all Claims whatever, as Witness my
hand & Seal this first Day of January 1789.
