Cattle with their future increase unto the said George Ro-
bison his Executors, Administrators and Assigns to him and his
only proper use and behoof for ever. And I the said William
Dunbar for myself my Heirs Executors &c all and singular
-lar the said Negroes and the said Stock of Cattle unto the
said George Robison his Executors Administrators and Assigns
against me the said William Dunbar and against all and
every person whatsoever do warrant and forever defend by
