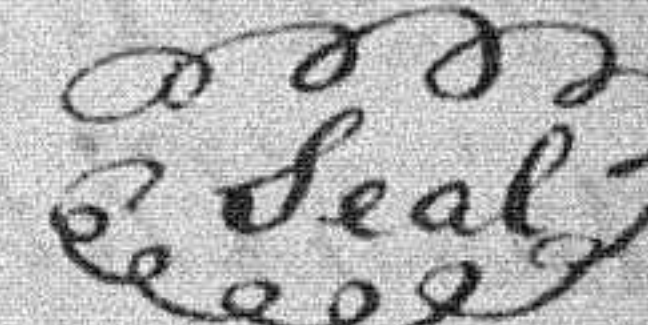


South Carolina Know all men by these

& sold & by these presents do bargain & sell & deliver to
the said Will^m Robison a Negro Wench Slave named
Afy. To have & to hold the said Negro Wench unto the s^d
William Robison his Executors Administrators & assigns
to his & their only proper use & behoof for Ever. And I
the said Mich^l Swicord my Exec^s & administrators the
said bargained Premises unto the said Will^m Robison
his Executors, administrators & assigns from & against
all Persons shall & will Warrant & for Ever defend by
these presents in Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand & Seal this twenty eight Day of Janu
ary one thousand seven hundred & ninety & in the
fourteenth Year of the Independance of North
America —

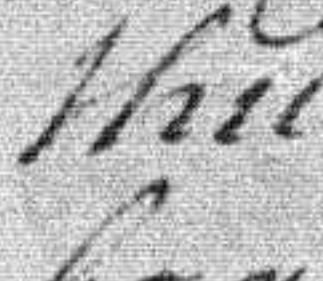
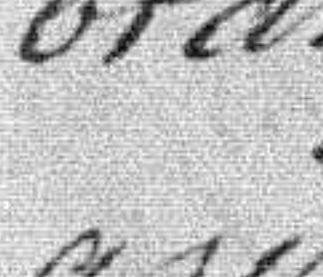

seven hundred & ninety between Will^m Brooker & his Wife
Unity Brooker both of the State of South Carolina & County
of Winton Witnesseth, that the said Will^m Brooker as well for
& in consideration of the Natural Love & affection which he
hath & beareth unto his said beloved Wife Unity Brooker
also of the sum of Thirty five Shillings Sterl. money to him
in hand paid by the said Unity Brooker, hath given
granted & confirmed & by these presents doth give, grant
& confirm unto the said Unity Brooker for Ever. All
that Stock of black Cattle containing about twenty
fore head of Cattle & marked with a Crop & two Slits in
one Ear and a under heel in the other & Branded thus
 & also a bay Mare about Ten Years old and branded
thus  and two Colts the Increase of the said Mare and
branded  as well in her own possession & custody
as in the custody or possession of any other person or
persons whatsoever as they now are or which at any
other Time hereafter during the Life of the s^d Unity
Brooker may be improved or increased To have
and to hold all & singular the said Horses and
Neat Cattle and all the other premises aforesaid unto
the said Will^m Brooker his Executors administrators and
assigns for Ever. Provided always & upon condition that
he the said Will^m Brooker his Executors administrators and
assigns, Do & shall permit her the said Unity Brooker To
have hold use occupy possess & enjoy the said Horses & Neat
Cattle for Ever and all & singular the premises above grant
ed unto the said Unity Brooker & for her Self her Executors
& administrators Doth covenant & agree to & with the said
Will^m Brooker Executors & administrators that the said
Will^m Brooker his Executors & administrators by & under
the condition aforesaid & not otherwise & al^y may peacea
bly & Quietly have hold & enjoy all & singular the Horses
& Neat Cattle & premises aforesaid without any Molestation
hindrance or Interruption by any person or persons what
soever claiming under her or by her act means or procurement

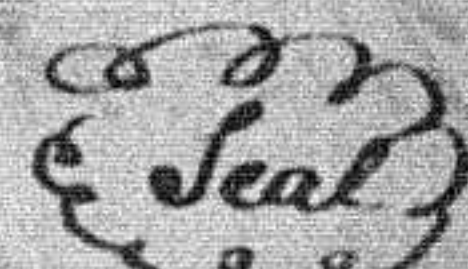

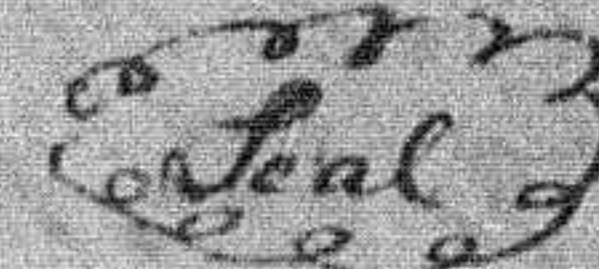

She the said Ann Moon hath Given granted & confirmed & by these presents doth give grant and confirm unto her the said Daughter Elizabeth Moon three Cows markd with an under heel & upper heel in each Ear. not traded To have & to hold all & singular the three head of Neat Cattle & there increase aforesaid unto the said Elizabeth Moon her Ex^{ors} Adm^{rs} & assigns for ever. And the said Ann Moore for her self her Executors. Administrators & assigns Doth Covenant grant & agree To & may peace ably & quietly have hold & enjoy all the Neat Cattle & premises aforesaid without any molestation what soever.
