

Know all men by these Presents that I Will^m Brown of Nase Hall in the State of Georgia for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred & thirty pounds at and before the ~~sealing~~ & delivering of these presents by Walter Robinson the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have bargained & sold & by these presents do hereby bargain & sell & deliver to the said Walter Robinson three Negro Slaves York, Hagar & Child to have & to hold the three Slaves with the future increase to the said Walter Robinson his Executors, administrators & assigns to his & their only proper use & behoof for Ever. & I the said Will^m Brown for my Self & my Heirs Executors Administrators & assigns from & against all persons shall & will Warrant & for Ever defend by these presents in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand & Seal Dated at Savannah on the fourth Day of November in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & eighty eight

Know all men by these presents that We Owen Odom & John Stuart of South Carolina & County of Winton Planters for & in consideration of the Sum of fifty five pounds to us in hand paid at & before the selling & delivery of these presents by Walter Robison Planter of said County the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge have bargained & sold & by these presents do bargain & sell & deliver unto the said Walter Robinson Planter a Negro Boy named Tom about eleven Years old I have & to hold the said Tom unto the said Walter Robinson his Executors administrators & assigns to his & his only proper use & behoof for Ever. And we the said Owen Odom & John Stuart for our selves our Heirs Executors and administrators the said bargained premises unto the said Walter Robinson his Executors administrators & assigns from & against all persons shall & will Warrant & for Ever defend by these presents in Witness whereof we have hereunto set our Hands & Seals Dated at the White Ponds twenty third Day of May in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & eighty nine & the thirteenth Year of the Independence of the untited States of North America
