Fryer of the State of South Carolina & County of Winton
Spinster, for & in consideration of the Love, good Will and
affection which I have & do bear towards my Loving & Duttyfull
Son John Fryer of the State & County aforesaid a Minor have
given & granted ~~by these~~ by these presents do freely Give
& grant unto the said John Fryer his Heirs Executors & Adminis-
trators all that Tract of Land containing one hundred Acres lying
& being in Winton County aforesaid, nearly adjoining a Pond called
Peters Pond, which said tract of Land was surveyed for Samp Griffin
the twenty fourth Day of August one thousand seven hundred and
Eighty four, & granted to him the 5th Day of June 1780, & conveyed to
Mary Fryer by Deeds of Lease & Release, as by the Grant for the same
& Lease & Release will fully & at large appear. Also one hundred &
fifty Acres of Land, lying & being in Winton County aforesaid, near
to the said Peters Pond, being part of a Tract of three hundred
Acres, surveyed for Mary Fryer the first Day of July one thousand
seven hundred & eighty four, & granted to her the fifth Day of July
one thousand seven hundred & eighty five, a Plat being hereunto An-
neaded & made a Part of this Deed of Gift. To have & to hold the said
Lands aforesaid, and all the rights titles privileges & immunities
thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, to him the said
John Fryer, his Heirs Executors or Administrators from henceforth
as his & their proper Right & State of Inheritance. Absolutely
without any manner of Consideration, in Witness whereof I
have hereunto put my Hand & Seal, this First Day of May
One thousand seven hundred & eighty nine, & of the Sovereignty
& Independence of the United States of North America the
fourteenth Year —

In the Name of God Amen — September the 1st 1788. I Will^m. Worritt
of the County of Winton & State of South Carolina, being sick & weak in
Body, but of sound & perfect Sense & memory thanks be to God for it. Do make
& ordaine this my Last Will & Testament in manner & form following.
Item I Recommend my Soul into the Hands of Almighty God, & my Body to
the Earth, to be buried in a decent Christian Manner at the Discretion
of my Executors hereafter named —
Item I give ^{& bequeath} to my Son John M. Worritt one Negroe Boy by the Name
of Will. after my Wifes Widowhood, also four hundred Acres of Land
lying & being the upper side of the Horse Penn. to be possessed with at the
Age of Twenty one Years to him & his Heirs for ever. —
Item I give & bequeath to my Son Thom^s. Worritt one Negro Boy by the
name of Amor, after my Wifes Widowhood, Also my Plantation &
Land whereon I now live, after the Death of my Wife & the Marriage
of all my Daughters, Viz^t. Polly, Suckey, Nancy, Sally & Tempe to him
& his Heirs for ever — Item I give & bequeath to my Son in Law
William Dyess, one hundred Acres of Land, lying betwixt Chand-
lers Land, & the upper Edge of the Little Gaspers Pond, & my Line near
the new Road, aforesaid Dyess's Line, to him & his Heirs for ever.

Item I lend to my Loving Wife Nancy Worritt, my Plantation
& Land there to belonging, indureing her Natural Life, Also I lend
her all the rest of my personal Estate indureing her Widowhood,
and after her Widowhood, my Will is that all my Estate but what
I have already given to my Sons, should be equally divided
between my Six Daughters, Viz^t. Elizabeth Dyess, Polly Worritt,
Suckey Worritt, Nancy Worritt, Sally Worritt, & Tempe Worritt, to them
& their Heirs for ever. — Item I constitute & make & ordaine my
Son Will^m. Dyess, & my loving Wife Nancy Worritt Joint-Executors of
this my last Will & Testament, Revoking & disanulling all other
former Wills, ratifying & confirming this my last Will & Testament
