Whereas no Regular Division of the property Heired by Law by My Beloved Sisters Mary Greer and Susanna Greer and Myself of the Estate of My Uncle Robt Greer Deceased, not any Division of the property we owned before or Accumulated Since the Same Came into our possession, I do Give and Bequeath unto the Said Mary Greer and Susanna Greer My Whole estate both personal and Real to be Equally Divided Between them, I do also nominate and appoint my friend John Kelsey Sr. to be My Sole Executor to this my Last Will and Testament.
