AGNESS CRAWFORD
STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA

In the name of God Amen:

I Agness Crawford having this day by deed disposed of all the estate which I have possessed except two negroes Viz Hannah and her child Becky and it being my anxious desire that they should be emancipated I do by this my last will and testament direct and require my executors to petition the Legislature of this State, at its first session after my decease for permission to emancipate the said negroes, Hannah and her child Becky, together with all their increase, and if the Legislature does refuse permission for the said negroes to be emancipated then it is my will and desire that the said negroes be vested in Alexander Crawford, and I do hereby give and bequeath the said negroes Hannah and her child Becky and all their increase to Alexander Crawford his heirs and assigns forever.

Signed, sealed and acknowledged to be my last will and testament and hereby revoking all others, this sixth day of November one thousand eight hundred and thirty four and in the presence of
