

In the Name of God Amen

I Andrew Floyd of York District, South Carolina being of sound & disposing mind & memory & desirous of settling my worldly affairs, do make & declare my last will & testament in manner & form following Viz.

Item 1 I will & bequeath to my daughter Mary I my three negroes Flora, Holly and Curry--my four horses, Mide & her colt, my gray horse Bill & a colt of Fancy's- a saddle and bridle-all my Household and Kitchen furniture, not hereinafter disposed of my farming utensils & Stock of cattle, sheep and hogs & my loom & tacklings---To have & to hold the aforementioned articles to her & her heirs forever

Item 2 I give to my daughter Mary I, for & during her natural life, that part of my plantation, on which I reside, lying on the West Side of the lane--and at her death, I give & devise the Same to my son George McWhorter Floyd, to have & to hold to him & his heirs forever.

Item 3 I give bequeath, and devise to my son George McWhorter Floyd, the remainder of the plantation on which I reside to have and to hold the Same to him & his heirs forever.

Item 4 I give and bequeath to my son George McWhorter Floyd my negro boy Minor & negro girl Margaret to him & his heirs forever.

Item 5 I give and bequeath to my son George, my negro man called George, upon condition that he pay to my son Henry Floyd, within six months after my decease, the sum of Five hundred dollars--Should my son George, refuse to comply with the above condition, then my will & desire is that the said boy should belong to my son Henry, to have & to hold to him & his heirs forever

Item 6 I give and bequeath to my son John Floyd my negro boy called Abner to have & to hold to him & his heirs forever.

Item 7 I give & devise to my two sons James & Robert, my tract of land on the waters of Beaver Dam, containing one hundred & five acres, to be equally divided between them as they may think proper.

Item 8 I give and bequeath to my daughter Dordas Brown, my negro boy named Stephen ---to her & heirs forever.

Item 9 I give and bequeath to my daughter Rachel Jeans, my negro boy, Cyrus---to her & her heirs forever

Item 10 I give and bequeath to my daughter Margaret B Jeans, my negro girl named Sue and her child called Minerva--to have & to hold the said negroes, to her & heirs forever.

Item 11 I give and bequeath to my Grandson John Brison Venable a negro boy called Sam, and a brown horse named Mile--to him & his heirs forever.

Item 12 I will & bequeath to my daughter Mary I my clock & waggon & gears.

Item 13 I will & desire that my son George, pay all my debts owing at my death & also my funeral expenes.

Item 14 I give & bequeath to my daughter Mary I, all the remainder of my estate, not herein specifcoully bequeathed & devised & the cash on hands at my death

Item 15 I hereby nominate, constitute & appoint my son George Executor of this my last will & testament, hereby revoking all former wills --In testimony whereof I have hereunto Set my hand & seal, the seventeenth day of April 1838 & 62nd. year of
