Do make and ordain this to be my Last will and testament in manner and form as following Viz this my Desire is that at my Death my Dear and beloved wife Elisabeth have one Negro Girl "amed mimy and all the house hold and Chitchen furniture and also one young diomed mare and Colt and two Cows and Calves and three Dry Cattle at her own Chuseing and also one third of my Stock of Sheep and hogs and also my Loom and taclin and also all my farming utensils as Long as She Sees Cause to farm and it is also my Desire that the moyty of money Coming from my fathers Estate to me to be "eft to my Wife Elisabeth ... and it is also my Desire that my Negro man asburn be sold for Cash as much as Need Requires and the Remainder on Credit and it is also my Desire that my Son John Green patterson have all my Lands that I Now possess and that my Wife Elisabeth have her Living of Said Land During her Life or widowhood it is my Desire that out of the proceeds of the property sold that my funeral Expenses and my Just Debts be paid that the Remainder be put to intres for the Education of my son John 6 paterson and I Do hereby utterly Disalow Revoke and Disanull All all former will or wills Testaments Legasees or bequithments Whatsoever & and I Do hereby Ratify and Confirm this

and no other to be my last will and Testament in winess
