the other half of my Cash and notes which ever it is in at my
Death I also give him one bed and furniture and one Big wheel
and one Chest Item third I give and bequeath unto my Neace
Patsey Plance my loom and tacklings Item fourth I leave Mary
Wallice two Dollars in Cash Item fifth I leave Margaret Plax-
co two Dollars in Cash Item Sixth I leave Jean Hemphill two
Dollars I also appoint my Brothers John Good and James Good
for Executors Witness my hand and seal this fifth day of April
and in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and
thirty two
