of my property--I wish to be equally divided between my two Sis-
ters Margaret Hanna and Jane Hanna and the said Janes part of
the money I do will & wish my executors to keep at interest for
her use and benefit during her natural life, and at her death-
my desire and will is that my sister Janes part of my estate be
divided between my two sisters Anna Black and Sarah E. Kerr to
have the two thirds and the said Anna Black one third of her
division of said estate

Further and lastly I do hereby ordain and appoint Dudely Jones
and Elijah Kerr my Executors of this my last Will & Testament
In witness whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this
twenty first day of March Eighteen hundred & Thirty four
