

In the Name of God Amen. I Archibald Stuart, of South Carolina York District, considering the uncertainty of this mortal life, and being of sound and perfect mind and memory, Blessed be Almighty God for the same, do make and publish this my last will and testament, in manner and form following, (that is to say)

First I give and bequeath unto my eldest son William Stuart one hundred Acres of land to be laid off where he now lives, to hold to him the said William Stuart and his lawful descendants for ever, upon condition that the said Wm. Stuart doth pay unto my four youngest daughters namely, Jane, Ann, Margaret and Sarah Stuart two hundred dollars to be equally divided amongst them. The said sum of two hundred dollars to be considered due six months after my decease. I also give and bequeath unto my youngest son Jos. B. Stuart the remainder of my tract of land situated on crowders creek in the aforesaid district of York, to hold to him the sd. Jos. B. Stuart his heirs and assigns forever, I further give & bequeath unto my son J. B. Stuart my waggon, farming utensils & my pattent clock; In consideration whereof the sd Jos. B. Stuart is to keep together and support my four daughters (already named) whilst they remain single. I also give & bequeath unto my Grand son James M Stuart (instead of his mother Agness Stuart) twenty dollars or a young horse of the same value, to be paid unto him when he shall arrive to the age of twenty one years. And lastly, after paying all Just debts and my funeral expenses I order that the remainder of my personal estate goods, chattels of what nature and kind soever to be equally divided between Joseph, Jane, Ann, Margaret & Sarah Stuart---

And I do hereby appoint my son Jos. B. Stuart and John A. Laney the executors of this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all former wills by me made. In Witness whereof I do hereunto Set my hand and Seal this 2nd day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & twenty eight.
