In the Name of God amen I Charles Curry, of the state of South Carolina and District of York, Being of perfect mind and memory, thanks be Given un to God; Calling unto mind the mortality of my Body, and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make and ordain this my last will and testament: that is to say, principally and first of all^k I Give and recommend my soul into the hand of Almighty God that Gave it, and my body I Recommend to the earth, to Be buried in a decent Christian burial, at the discretion of my Executors--Nothing Doubting but at the General Resurrection I Shall Recieve the Same again by the mighty power of God, And as touching Such worldly Estate Wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this life, I Give dimise, and dispose of the same in the following Manner and form, First I Give and bequeath to my Beloved Wife Prudence Curry, all my tract of Land that is Whereon I now Live Containing five hundred Acres more or Less During her Life time or widowhood at her Death or Marriage to Be Equally Divided Betwixt my two Sons McConael Curry and Robert Curry, I also will unto my Wife Prudence Curry my stock of horses that is after my two Sons McConnel Curry & Robert Curry takes each of them theyr Choice out of them and all my Stock of Cows hogs & Sheep and house hole & Kitchen furniture to my Wife Prudence Curry Dureing her Life of widowhood at her death or marriage to Be equally Divided Betwixt my four Childred McConnel Curry and Robert Curry, & Margaret H. M. Curry & Elizabeth Curry, after the Death or marrage of my wife Prudence Curry at Which time my two sons McConnel & Robert Curry is to enjoy my Landit is my will, that McConnel Curry Gives to my Daughter Margaret Hill Curry one hundred Dollars, & my son Robert Curry to my Daughter Elizabeth Curry one hundred Dollars, Secondly

at the time that market can be made out of my present Crop that is
now on hands I do Will and Bequeath unto my Beloved sons John M Cur-
ry and Andrew Curry & Thomas Curry & William Curry & James C Curry
& Charles Curry Each of them five Shillings Fourthly I do Will un-
to my two Sons McConnel Curry & Robert Curry My Mashien and Runing
geers and all my farming tools, of all Descreptions- I do also leave
John M Curry & William Guy Executors of this my Last Will & Testa-
ment Give under my hand and Seal this 6th July 1816
